



Big Desert Motorcycle Rally

From: Saturday 2nd to Monday 4th October 2010.

at: Broken Bucket Bore, east of Nhill-Murrayville Road, 20kms NW of Yanac (NW of Nhill), Victoria.

This will be the 7th Big Desert Motorcycle Rally since the first in 1981.

to assist the: *Royal Flying Doctor Service.* dedicated to: *John Schoolderman.*

the Commemorative badges: 200 - in genuine enamel - designed along the lines of the original 1981 badge.

Rally signs: will be posted on the Nhill-Murrayville Road which is now sealed from Yanac and Nhill.

It is also easily accessible from Kaniva via Broughton, but some intersections are unmarked.

From the north, it is a dry-weather-only road and is referred to as the Nhill-Murrayville Track.

If conditions are dry, access is possible via Murrayville but not to be attempted if wet.

For experienced off-roaders, the Milmed Track from Wyperfeld NP should be a challenge.

Water: BYO; though good quality Bore water is available at Broken Bucket Bore.

Toilets: long-drop toilets are available both at Broken Bucket Bore and up north at Big Billy Bore.

Bring: just about everything; but no glass containers; leave only tyreprints; tea/coffee provided.

Badges: \$12 if paid by 28/09/10; \$15 at the rallysite; re-orders will be posted out.

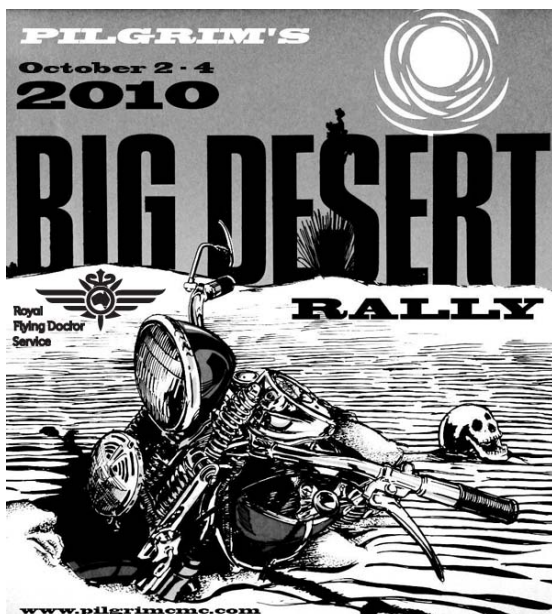
Tee-Shirts: \$18 (incl your size in cm), collect at the BDR or add \$7 postage.
