The annual Ridden On Ride allows family, friends and the motorcycle community the opportunity to attend a simple nondenominational memorial service for these riders.

Motorcyclists will leave the Victoria Hotel, O'Halloran Hill on Main South Road at 10:00am for an organised ride to Second Valley, where a short service will be held then we will ride to Victor Harbor via Delamere. Cars are to follow the riders. Please advise an organiser on the day of any cars participating.

Ride Badges will be sold on the day with profits being donated to the Royal Flying Doctor Service. If you support the RFDS you may buy a badge without joining in on this event.

The 2007 ride raised \$700.00. This was donated by the MRA's 4'Bs (Bent and Buckled Bikers Brigade) to the Orthopaedics Ward, third floor of the North Wing of the RAH. This purchased 3 portable DVD players and over 50 movies to form the nucleus of a DVD library.
