The ride plan is to follow the SE Freeway out the city to Mt Barker. Here we will leave the Freeway and follow the Princess Highway (so we can put some bends in the ride) through Murray Bridge and on to Tailem Bend.

After a smoko at Tailem Bend on to the Meningie Bakery for lunch. After lunch on to Salt Creek for a short smoko and into Kingston SE just in time for pre-dinner drinks in front of the warm log fire!
